Head Injury / Concussion Agreement & Release Form

Any player participating in EVW Youth Football who has sustained a previous head injury requiring medical attention, or has been diagnosed with a concussion of any severity, including a mild concussion, must provide EVW Youth Football with a medical release note or form from a licensed medical physician to participate in practice or games in the 2009 season.

Additionally, any player that sustains a head injury during the 2009 season requiring medical attention, including any type of diagnosed concussion, must sit out of all practices and games until they have provided a signed medical release from their physician, and provided a copy of that form to EVW Youth Football.

All players who have suffered any head injury requiring medical attention will be required to wear a protective air helmet, in addition to, providing a medical release, in order to participate in any future practice or game in the EVW Youth Football League.

I, the parent or guardian of the below named player for the EVW Youth Football League, hereby acknowledge the understanding of this policy and take all responsibility for providing medical information, medical care, providing a medical release and providing an air helmet in the event your child participating in EVW Youth Football, has previously suffered a head injury requiring medical attention, or does so during the 2009 EVW Youth Football Season.

I hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the EVW Midget Football League, Omaha City Parks & Recreation, Elkhorn Public Schools, Logan-Magnolia Public Schools, Missouri Valley Public Schools, DC West Public Schools, Arlington Public Schools, Bennington Public Schools, Blair Public Schools, Gretna Public Schools, Fort Calhoun Public Schools, Omaha Public and Archdiocese Schools, Ashland Public Schools, Springfield Public Schools, Plattsmouth Public Schools, Hickman Public Schools, Norris Public Schools, Nebraska City Public Schools, Auburn Public Schools, Murray-Conestoga Public Schools, Malcolm Public Schools and Yutan Public Schools. All officials, directors, organizers, coaches and all board members from any claim(s) arising from injury to the player.

All information provided will be held confidential by the EVW Youth Football League and only those officials, including the EVW Board of Directors, the players team coach and the local community leader will be made aware of previous or current season head injury / concussion injuries to your child.

I understand that EVW Youth Football does not provide Health Insurance for my child and that I am responsible for providing health insurance coverage in the event of injury or illness.
